### 停止種族抹黑 理性討論難民事件

近月也有傳媒大篇幅報道南亞裔人士及滯留本港等待核實酷刑聲請者的犯案新聞。隨之引起公眾輿論，有政黨、團體提出重建禁閉營，亦有種族歧視的評論出現。這些針對在港難民及少數族裔將引發種族恐懼和仇恨，破壞社會共融。我們不容許香港的社會和諧繼續受到踐踏。我們懇請社會各方冷靜下來，理性地討論難民事件。有見及此，我們多個關注人權組織、民間組織、非政府組織、專業團體及宗教團體，發起聯署聲明。至今已獲得超過八十個團體及專業人士聯署支持。聯署聲明將在記者招待會中發放。

**Press Invitation**

**Stop Discrimination: Community Calls for Calm on Refugee Debate**

We noticed that some media have been widely reported news linking asylum seekers and the South Asian to crime in recent months, which arouse the public discussion. There are irresponsible comments made regarding the refugee issue in Hong Kong. At the same time, some proposals that have been put forward – such as Hong Kong’s withdrawal from UN Convention Against Torture (‘UNCAT’) or closed detention camps. These comments are fueling a climate of fear and hostility towards both refugees and ethnic minorities alike, and run the risk of fracturing Hong Kong’s diverse and vibrant community. For this reason we cannot in good conscience allow this to continue. In shared concern, we are joined together to send out a call for calm. It is time for a sober and more reasoned approach.

In view of this, the human rights organization, civil society organizations, non-governmental organizations, professional associations and religious groups issued a joint statement. At present, we have received more than eighty organizations and professional affiliate to support. The joint statement will be issued at the press conference.
