## Justice Centre **Information Sessions for Claimants**

### **USM 1: How to **apply** to the Unified Screening Mechanism (USM)**

How to **make a claim** for protection in Hong Kong.

### **USM 2: How to **prepare** for the USM**

What to do and expect **after you have made a claim** for protection in Hong Kong.

### **USM 3: **Appeals** and **Judicial Reviews (JRs)****

What to do if your **USM claim has been rejected** by HK Immigration and/or the Torture Claims Appeal Board.

**Know Your Rights** – Your rights in Hong Kong, including in relation to immigration, the police, education, employment, family, and discrimination.

**Immigration Options** – Immigration options other than the USM, including dependent visas, voluntary repatriation, immigration to other countries, and leaving Hong Kong.

**Drop-in Questions and Answers about your Claim** – If you have **questions about your claim**, drop in and ask on **Thursday morning from 10 am – 12 noon on 18/F**. **Bring your own interpreter**. Due to limited staff availability, if you would like to talk to our **French-speaking legal staff**, please call in advance to make an appointment in advance.

**Transport money for drop-in: HK\$60/adult and HK\$30/child** aged 3-12 years will be provided for your first initial drop-in during the drop-in hours above.

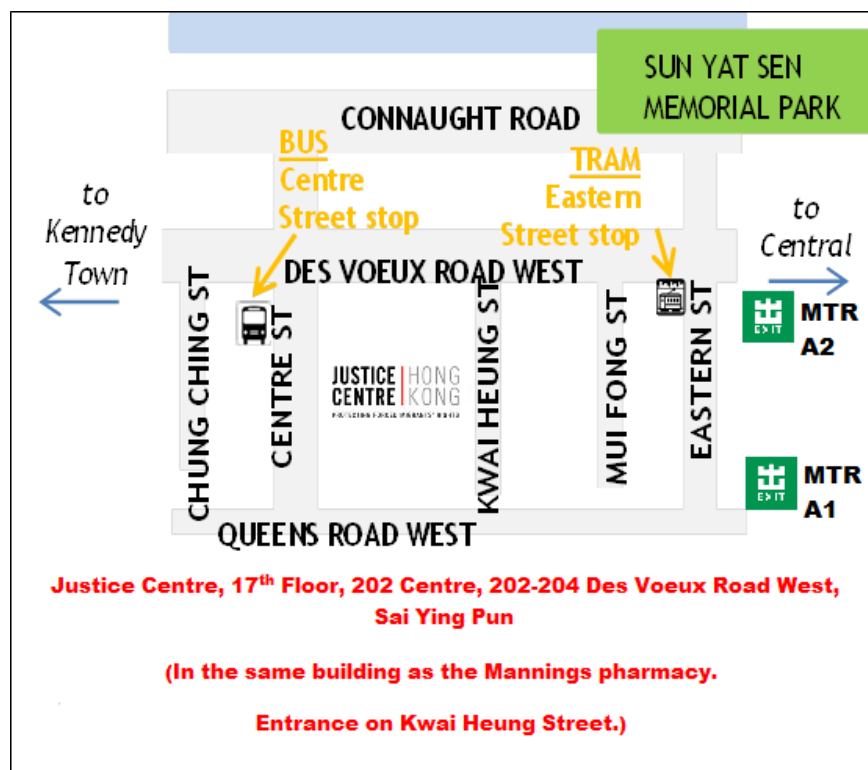
- Each session will include **easy-to-understand information** about the topic.

  - For **USM sessions**, an **individual and private assessment interview** if you would like **individual services** in **YOUR** case. We will explain how we can help with individual services.

**Food and drinks** and **HK\$60/adult** and **HK\$30/child** aged 3-12 years will be provided for one attendance at each session topic only (for example, you will only be paid once per person for 'USM: How to apply', once per person for 'USM: How to prepare' and once per person for the 'Know Your Rights' sessions). You are welcome to attend a session on the same topic more than once but we will only pay transport money for attendance at each type of information session once.

- If you are more than **30 minutes late**, you cannot attend the session or receive any money.

You can find us at:



**MTR/Train:** We are a 1-minute walk from Sai Ying Pun MTR Station. Leave the station from either Exit A2 (Des Voeux Road West) or Exit A1 (Queen's Road West) and follow the map.

**Ferry:** We are a 20-minute walk from the Central Star Ferry pier.

**Bus:** From Sheung Wan Station (exit A1), take westbound buses 5B, 5S, 1, or 905 to CENTRE STREET stop or 113 to EASTERN STREET stop.

**Tram:** From Sheung Wan Station (exit B) or Central Station (exit B1), take westbound tram to EASTERN STREET stop.
