Know Your Rights – Your rights in Hong Kong, including in relation to immigration, the police, education, employment, family, and discrimination.

NEW! Immigration Options – Immigration options other than the USM, including dependent visas, voluntary repatriation, immigration to other countries, and leaving Hong Kong.

Drop-in Questions and Answers about your Claim – If you have **questions about your claim**, drop in and ask on **Thursday morning from 10am - 12pm on 18/F**. **Bring your own interpreter.**

- If you are more than **30 minutes late**, you cannot attend the session or receive any money.

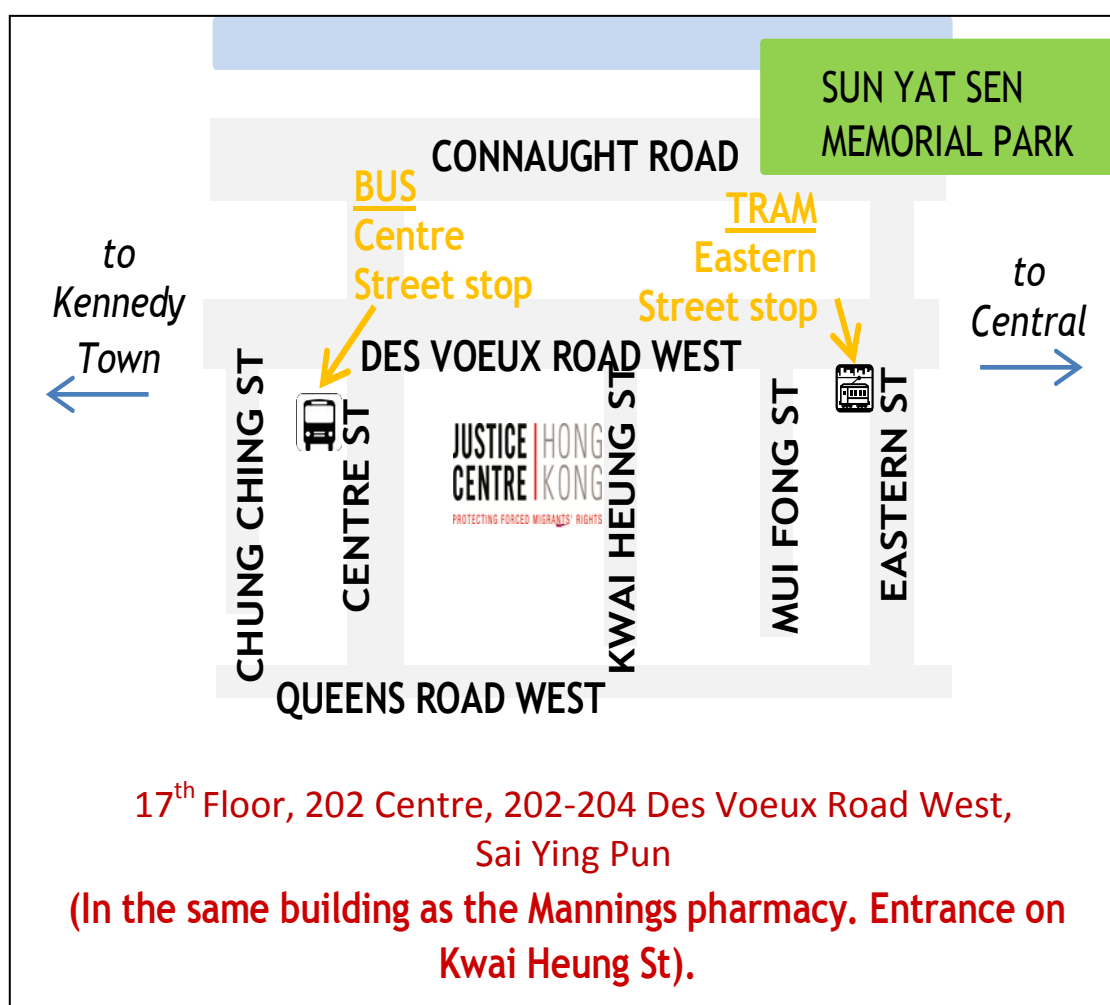
