# Information on USM Claimants:

# 1. Can the Immigration Department please provide statistics on the following:

# (a) The number of "written significations" received from 3 March 2014 to 3 March 2015

Since the commencement of the Unified Screening Mechanism ("USM") on 3 March 2014 till 28 February 2015, the ImmD has received a total of 6 039 written significations requesting for non-refoulement protection.

# (b), (c) & (d)

The number of claims withdrawn/taken NFA, outstanding and determined from 3 March 2014 to 3 March 2015

The breakdown by country of origin on the number of claims withdrawn/taken NFA, outstanding claims, claims determined from 3 March 2014 to 28 February 2015 is tabulated below:-

#### (e) The number of claims substantiated at first Instance from 3 March 2014 to 3 March 2015

Since the commencement of the USM on 3 March 2014 till 28 February 2015, there were 4 non-refoulement claims substantiated at first tier concerning 1 Sri Lankan and 3 Rwandan.

# (f) The number of USM appeals filed from 3 March 2014 to 3 March 2015

The number of appeals/petitions lodged under USM from 3 March 2014 to 3 March 2015 were 1 096. The ImmD does not maintain readily available information on the breakdown of appeal cases by country of origin.

# (g) The number of USM closed appeals on 3 March 2014 to 3 March 2015

There were 130 appeals/petitions under USM finalized from 3 March 2014 to 3 March 2015. The ImmD does not maintain readily available information on the breakdown of finalized USM appeals by country of origin since 3 March 2014.

# (h) The number of USM claims substantiated from 3 March 2014 to 3 March 2015 on appeal

There was 1 allowed appeal case under the USM from 3 March 2014 to 3 March 2015 concerning a Pakistani national.

As at 28 February 2015, there were 9 533 outstanding non-refoulement claims under processing. According to the addresses provided by the claimants, their location of accommodation in Hong Kong by region is as follows:
