

APPENDIX 1A: Survey Instrument

SURVEY QUESTIONNAIRE OF WORKING CONDITIONS FOR MIGRANT DOMESTIC WORKERS IN HONG KONG

This document shows the survey instrument used by Justice Centre Hong Kong to measure the prevalence of forced labour and trafficking for the purposes of forced labour amongst employed migrant domestic workers in Hong Kong in April 2015. The document shows the questions asked and which questions triggered which indicators. Responses were used to calculate whether a survey respondent could be counted as being in forced labour or having been trafficked for the purpose of forced labour.

Note: The questionnaire should be read in tandem with Appendix 4 showing the full list and definitions of the Justice Centre indicators for forced labour and trafficking for the purposes of forced labour.

The questionnaire was administered on e-tablets by teams of field researchers across 11 geographical zones in Hong Kong. Survey participants completed the questionnaire themselves in quiet spaces, and could choose the language in which they completed the survey, with a text-to-speech function for anyone with limited literacy. Written information in the native language and native speakers were also available to explain the study in more detail and answer any questions.




